

FRANCIS J. PANDICH, JR. SCHOLARSHIP

Francis J. Pandich, Jr., was a dedicated member of the O. L. Davis Fire Company of the Endwell Fire District for 41 years, from 1978 when he joined until his passing in 2019. During this time, he served the residents of the Endwell Fire District in numerous capacities: first as a firefighter, later as a Lieutenant and Assistant Fire Chief. In 1998 he was elected to the Board of Fire Commissioners and served as Chairman of the Board of Fire Commissioners for 20 years from 1999 to 2019. Throughout his life Fran was dedicated to community service.

Because of his great commitment to community service, members of the O. L. Davis Fire Company felt it fitting to create a scholarship in his name to reward students who were actively involved in serving their community.

AWARD: \$500 (one-time) to four eligible students.

ELIGIBILITY: For students graduating in 2024 and attending an accredited school or university in the fall of 2024. The student must be a resident of the Endwell Fire District and attend one of the following high schools:

- Maine-Endwell High School
- Union-Endicott High School
- Johnson City High School
- Seton Catholic High School

CRITERIA: This Scholarship will be awarded based on the student's community service involvement. Extra credit will be given to those students who are involved in emergency services or who have family members who are volunteer firefighters or EMS volunteers.

Please include your resume and recommendation letters from **two** adults, such as teachers, coaches, employers, etc. are required to be submitted with the application.

DEADLINE: The application must be **RECEIVED** no later than May 1, 2024.
